UNCG LIAISON and VIRTUAL REHEARSAL

Each winning playwright has been assigned a Liaison from UNCG's Theatre Education Department to assist you throughout the Showcase. Your liaison is CCed to this email. Winning playwrights will be invited by their UNCG Liaison to attend a **virtual rehearsal that will take place on April 5th or 6th**. The purpose of this rehearsal is to allow the playwright to get a behind the scenes look at the process of performing a staged reading and to see how their words are being interpreted by the director and actors. At this rehearsal playwrights might be asked questions about their play, they may also be invited to ask the director and actors questions about the staging, but they will not be expected to direct or make changes to the performance.
